

Recommendation to upload your accepted manuscript to your institutional repository.

The institutional repository is one way to make your work available to the community in an open-access form. ANM is not currently an open-access journal but using the institutional repository you can make your article an open-access one. By doing so, your article will be exposed to more researchers and you can contribute to scientific development more than by simply publishing your article in a journal.

Most academic institutions have their own repository, and so you may ask your library or department for detailed information.

Please keep in mind that pdf files obtained from Springer are prohibited from being uploaded to any institutional repository. Instead, upload your own final files of the manuscript that has been accepted for publication, provided it is only made publicly available at least 12 months after official publication. In addition, please do not forget to put the DOI (Digital object identifier) of your article in the footnote. DOI is a unique code set for each article, and is assigned when your article appears as an online first article on the ANM web site.
