

## **Prerequisites for Publication**

Articles are accepted for exclusive publication in the *Journal of Artificial Organs*. By submitting a paper, authors guarantee that they have not submitted and will not submit a similar paper for publication elsewhere in any language. If part or all of a paper has been presented at any scientific meeting, this must be declared in a footnote to the title page. Articles accepted for publication become the property of the Japanese Society for Artificial Organs and may not be published elsewhere in the same form without the written consent of the Editorial Board.

The Editors of the *Journal of Artificial Organs* subscribe to recommendations formulated by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors [<http://www.icmje.org>] regarding criteria for authorship. Accordingly, each person listed as an author or coauthor for a submitted report must meet all three of the following criteria.

An author or coauthor must have:

1. conceived, planned, and performed the work leading to the report, or interpreted the evidence presented, or both;
2. written the report or reviewed successive versions and shared in their revisions;
3. approved the final version.

Meeting these criteria should provide each author with sufficient knowledge of and participation in the work that he or she can accept public responsibility for the report. The senior or corresponding author is requested to certify that all listed authors meet the above three criteria.

Investigations in humans must be in accordance with the ethical standards of the responsible

committee (institutional or regional) on human experimentation or with the Helsinki Declaration of 1964 and all subsequent revisions.

Papers are welcomed from members of the Society and nonmembers alike.

## **Conflict of Interest Disclosure Statement**

When submitting a manuscript to *Journal of Artificial Organs*, all authors are required to indicate whether or not they have a financial relationship with the organization that sponsored the research according to the conflict of interest policy of the Japanese Society for Artificial Organs (<http://www.jsao.org/tools/file/download.cgi/314/Guidelines+for+Conflict+of+Interest+Issues+Related+to+Clinical+Studies+in+Artificial+Organs.pdf>)

In a manuscript to *Journal of Artificial Organs*, all disclosure should be inserted in the “Conflict of interest” before the reference list.

If there is no Conflict of Interest, it also should be specified.

Example: A (author name) serves as a consultant to Z (entity name); B’s spouse is chairman of Y; C received a research grant from X; D received lecture fees from V; E holds a patent on U; F has been reimbursed by T for attending several conferences; G received honoraria for writing promotional material for S; H has no conflict of interest.
