Motivation, Aim and Scope:


The International Precipitation Working Group was initiated in 2000 after the 52nd session of the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) Executive Council recommended involving relevant science groups in a systematic manner to improve satellite system utilization. The group was subsequently endorsed by the Coordination Group for Meteorological Satellites (CGMS). IPWG is interested in quantitative precipitation measurements from operational and research perspectives. Its endeavor is to foster the development of better precipitation measurements; the improvement of scientific understanding of the related processes; and the development of international partnerships. The 9th workshop was held in Seoul following previous workshops in Madrid (2002), Monterey (2004), Melbourne (2006), Beijing (2008), Hamburg (2010), São José dos Campos (2012), Tsukuba (2014), and Bologna (2016). In the IPWG-9 over 100 talks and poster works were presented. This special issue would focus the various researches on precipitation sciences, remote sensing, validation, hydrological applications of precipitation data from the IPWG-9.
