

## Instructions for Authors

### **Manuscript submission:**

The volumes of the book series can be solicited by the series editors or proposed by the prospective authors using the form available on the website of the series: <https://www.springer.com/series/8881>

### **Our peer review policy:**

In order to maintain our high standard of our publications, each submission is subjected to peer review to assess the validity, quality and originality of the proposed material.

This means that

- For projects submitted to a specific series, all proposals are reviewed by the series editor and Springer. In some cases, series editor may request a proposal to be reviewed externally;
- For projects that are outside of the scope of the existing Springer series, for projects in series that do not have series editors or for project put together by series editors themselves, all proposals are reviewed by two external peers;
- After the final manuscript has been submitted, it is sent for review to at least two external reviewers who are experts in the field;
- If the manuscript was recommended for publication after revision, the revised version may be sent out for another round of reviews;
- Authors should submit an outline of responses and changes together with the revised manuscript;

The final decision to accept or reject the manuscript is made by the series editors in conjunction with the publisher (or by Springer's gatekeepers for projects outside of series). Note that the peer review is single-blind.

### **Ethical requirements:**

Authors need to disclose any conflict of interest they might have, funding sources and in addition have to confirm that experiments described in the chapter involving humans or animals were conducted by respecting the corresponding ethical guidelines and that informed consent was obtained in case humans were involved. Authors should include these statements in a separate section entitled “Compliance with Ethical Standards” after the acknowledgments and before the references section as outlined in the Book Ethics Policy on this website. <https://www.springer.com/series/8881>

Authors have to follow the Book Ethics Policy.

Manuscripts are checked for plagiarism.
