

Key Style Points: Figures and Illustrations

- 1 **Figure captions**
 - ▶ Figure captions begin with the term **Fig.** in bold type, followed by the figure number, also in bold type.
 - ▶ Figure parts are identified by lowercase letters in bold.
 - ▶ Letters or words identifying specific positions or items in a figure are italicized.
 - ▶ Previously published material is identified by a reference to the original source at the end of the caption.
 - ▶ Figure captions have no end punctuation and no period after the figure number.

- 2 In the PDF version figures will appear at the top of the page as close as possible to their first citation.

- 3 **Figure size**
 - ▶ 78 mm wide with the figure placed on the right and the caption on the left.
 - ▶ 119 mm wide with the caption placed below the figure.

- 4 **Figure lettering and labeling**
 - ▶ Minimum size of 2 mm (6 pt) for lettering.
 - ▶ Part figure labels in lowercase letters.

- 5 **Color figures** will appear in color in the eBook but will usually be printed in black and white.
