

### **Our peer review policy**

In order to maintain our high standard of our publications, each submission is subjected to peer review to assess the validity, quality and originality of the proposed material.

This means that

- Publisher may request a proposal to be reviewed externally;
- After the final manuscript has been submitted, it is sent for review to at least two external reviewers who are experts in the field;
- If the manuscript was recommended for publication after revision, the revised version may be sent out for another round of reviews;
- Authors should submit an outline of responses and changes together with the revised manuscript;
- The final decision to accept or reject the manuscript is made by the publisher.

Note that the peer review is single-blind.
