

Peer review policy

In order to maintain the high standard of the publications in this series, each book proposal and manuscript submission is subjected to peer review to assess the quality and originality of the proposed material. This means that:

- Unsolicited initial proposals may be assessed internally or sent to the series editor and/or external reviewers for assessment. All final manuscripts are sent to external reviewers who are experts in the relevant field(s).
- In case reviewers recommend publication after revisions, the revised manuscript may be sent out for another round of reviewing. In such cases authors will be requested to submit a list of responses to reviewers' comments and changes that were made to the text together with the revised manuscript.
- The final decision to accept or reject the manuscript is made by the series editor in conjunction with Springer.

Note that the peer review process is single-blind.
