

Policies for Reviewers

Conflict of Interest Rules

As a reviewer, you are considered to have a conflict of interest on a paper that has an author or a co-author in any of the following categories:

- your former and current graduate students
- your graduate advisors
- members of your research group within the last 5 years
- a colleague of your current institute within the last 3 years
- co-author of a paper submitted for publication within the last 3 years
- a cooperation partner of some research project within the last 3 years
- a member of your family

and any person where, for whatever reason, you feel biased.

Confidentiality Policy

The material you receive in the course of the reviewing process, including abstracts, papers, tools, experiments, opinions of other reviewers, as well as any information regarding the discussion and acceptance/rejection decisions should be treated with the utmost confidentiality. It must not be used in any way except for reviewing purposes.



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
