

Review process for contributions published in the *Masterclass in Neuroendocrinology* series

The book series *Masterclass in Neuroendocrinology* publishes only solicited contributions, which are invited by the volume or series editors.

1st round of review: Submitted manuscripts are first reviewed by the volume editors, who are experts in the field of the volume. In cases of particular concern, a system of single-blind or double-blind review is used in which advice is sought from independent external experts who may or may not know the identity of the authors.

2nd round of review: The manuscripts approved by the volume editors are then subjected to a technical examination at Springer, followed by a review by the series editors.

Where the reviewers (volume editors, series editors or external reviewer) recommend revision and/or improvements to the chapters, authors are asked to address such recommendations adequately and to resubmit the revised chapter.

The reviewing of manuscripts by the volume editors and series editors includes a check for scientific soundness and coherence of the manuscript and the adherence to the guidelines for the *Masterclass in Neuroendocrinology* series regarding style, content and level of writing.

The technical review by Springer comprises a check for plagiarism, the completeness of the chapter and the compliance with the guidelines for the *Masterclass in Neuroendocrinology* series regarding chapter organization.

Volume and series editors jointly decide on the suitability of each manuscript for the *Masterclass in Neuroendocrinology* series on the basis of their reviews.
