Each volume of LNSN should have a glossary of keywords used in the chapters. This glossary for the entire volume, will directly follow the preface in the volume. The purpose of this is to clarify how the given terms are used within the given volume. As network sciences are by nature interdisciplinary, the definition of terms can be very beneficial for readers. Volume editors can either inform contributing authors of chapters to provide these for their contributions, and / or provide these for all chapters themselves. In either case, the volume editor (s) will have the final decision as to what definition is used for the volume in the glossary. There is no required number of terms for the glossary, and this may vary from only a few terms to quite a few. The number of necessary terms to be included in the glossary will also be left to the discretion of the volume editor.
