We aim to have the complete work peer-reviewed within 3 months of the submission of the manuscript.

Proposals should include:

- A short synopsis of the work or the introduction chapter
- The proposed Table of Contents
- CV of the lead author(s)
- List of courses for possible course adoption

Submission of manuscript

- Submit two versions of manuscript - 1 blinded (for peer review), 1 un-blinded

The series discourages the submission of manuscripts that are below 85,000 words in length.
